Cosmic Songs: Consciousness and Invisible Worlds

Featuring Kurt Leland

The invisible realms which include the subtle aspects of our own human bodies. But how many of us are aware of our subtle bodies and how they are relating to other planes or fields of reality? Kurt Leland, our 2013 state convention presenter, is very aware of his subtle



bodies and other planes of reality. He will be sharing with us at the Convention being held at the beautiful DaySpring Retreat Center in Parrish, FL.

Kurt began having out-of-body experiences as a teenager. Though fearful at first of these nonphysical experiences, he discovered the writings of other out-of-body experiencers and thus became a researcher/explorer himself. He writes about his personal explorations of other realms in his books: *Otherwhere: A Field Guide to Nonphysical Reality for the Out-of-Body Traveler* and *The Unanswered Question: Death, Near-Death and the Afterlife.* His latest is *The Multidimensional Human: Practices for Psychic Development and Astral Projection.*

In 2005 Kurt came across Theosophist, Annie Besant's book, *Man and his Bodies* which started him on a course of deep reading in Theosophical materials including Arthur Powell's comprehensive accounts of the bodies and planes in his four books *The Etheric Double, The Astral Body, The Mental Body* and *The Causal Body and the Ego*. Powell's information is based primarily on the writings of Annie Besant, C. W. Leadbeater and H. P. Blavatsky.

Kurt was greatly impressed by Annie Besant's writings and his research on

her work resulted in a contract with Quest Books, the publishing arm of the Theosophical Society in America. Kurt's book will come out this year under the title *In*visible Worlds: Annie Besant on Psychic and Spiritual Development.

Parallel to his work on consciousness studies is his work in music. He is a professional musician and has been active for decades as a composer and clarinetist. He has been fascinated since childhood with what he now calls Transcendent Musical Experiences (TMEs). These are mystical experiences associated with composing, performing and listening to music. Many people have TMEs which range from physical sensations such as chills running up the spine, to feelings of being moved to tears, and even mystical visions. Kurt believes that TMEs are messages from our souls intended to guide us on our spiritual journey. His recent book Music and the Soul: A Listener's Guide to Transcendental Musical Experiences helps us identify and enhance the states of consciousness encoded in music and use it to promote spiritual growth.

Kurt's presentations at the Convention will reflect his research and life experience in both music and also nonphysical reality. He will help us explore our spiritual depths in both areas.
