Pablo's talk: Dzyan Theosophy: The Theosophical Path of Meditation

Though the Theosophical approach to meditation refrains from promoting any particular (and therefore limited) system, there are specific recommendations about meditation in our literature. We can find a number of methods suggested, some of them unique, based on distinct Theosophical elements: the unity of life, the subtle bodies, and the Masters. In this program we will explore and practice different techniques of meditation recommended by Theosophical authors including H.P. Blavatsky, Annie Besant, C.W. Leadbeater, I.K. Taimni, Clara Codd, Geoffrey Hodson, and Jiddu Krishnamurti.

Also, we are honored to present **Dr. Fred deWit**, a practicing psychologist from Wichita, KS, a second generation theosophist and member of The Ozark Camp, who will speak on "Science, Christianity, Theosophy—What answers or non-answers can they give us?—Some Reflections."

Grace Way, flutist and drummer of Topeka, KS and **Bill Swalwell** will lead us in a drumming circle around the campfire.

Also, **Gini Newcomb** and **Grace Way** will guide us in QiGong and gentle exercises.
