"THEOSOPHY AND THE DIVINE PROPORTION"

HPB states that "Plato is the world's interpreter." As an initiate of the Eleusinian, Pythagorean and Egyptian Mysteries, Plato's Secret Doctrine (veiled within his dialogues) holds a great key to understanding the roots and goals of the Theosophical Society.

Scott Olsen, Ph.D., is a Professor of Philosophy & Religion at the College of Central Florida, Scott first received international acclaim by successfully decoding the geometric mysteries of Plato. His book, *The Golden Section: Nature's Greatest Secret* received rave reviews, and in 2007 was awarded a 1st place for design by the Bookbinders' Guild of New York. It is now published in 8 foreign languages: Greek, Russian, Slovenian, Czech, Norwegian, Chinese, Japanese and Korean. A life-long student of the Ancient Wisdom, he has studied under physicist David Bohm, world religion expert Huston Smith, sacred geometers Keith Critchlow & John Michell, and esotericist Douglas Baker. A member of the Theosophical Society in America, Scott lectures widely on the Perennial Philosophy (in both its ancient and modern forms) with special emphasis on the Divine Proportion and transformative states of consciousness. In 2009 he assisted Alexey Stakhov with his highly acclaimed book, *The Mathematics of Harmony: From Euclid to Contemporary Mathematics and Computer Science*. He is presently on sabbatical working on his new book, *Divine Proportion: the Mathematical Perfection of the Universe*, due out in the spring of 2013. In June of 2012, Scott will travel to the Bibliotheca Alexandrina, Egypt where he will present a workshop on *The Philosopher Mathematicians of Alexandria: Euclid and Hypatia*, and then to Carnac, France to lecture on *The Divine Proportion: Nature's Design Principle*. Applying his knowledge of proportional symmetry in physique competition, Scott won 1st place as Mr. Minneapolis, Mr. Twin Cities, Mr. Gainesville, Mr. Northeast Florida, and Mr. Apollo. A member of the Florida Bar, he resides in Ocala, Florida.
