Moving westward, the group ravel through Gyantse on their way to the full moon celebration of Saga Dawa at Tashi Lhunpo Monastery in Shigatse. They finish in Lhasa, visiting and meditating in many of the power places blessed by Tsongkhapa and the various Dalai Lamas. This tour was led by Glenn Mullin, an internationally known scholar, Tibetologist, meditation teacher, and translator of books on Tibetan Buddhism.
