Thoreau was not well respected during his lifetime and it is only during the twentieth century that he gained fame for his writings, especially for his most notable work, *Walden*. Dr. Algeo treats *Walden* as a spiritual journey, drawing some interesting parallels between the ideals of Thoreau and the key tenets of Buddhism.
