


Guest lecturer: Kurt Leland

To investigate the unexplained laws of Nature and the powers latent in humanity" is one object of the Theosophical Society. Annie Besant (1847–1933), outspoken feminist, political activist, and early president of the TS, thought that psychic and spiritual development should be available to everyone, not just a chosen few. In her many books and essays, her goal was not to help students develop supernormal powers, but to help them increase consciousness. Besant believed that her study, the guidance she

received and her work had positively changed her life and wanted others to enjoy the same benefit. Annie Besant's essays, compiled and annotated by Kurt Leland in his book "Invisible Worlds" were penned a century ago. Her wisdom on the subject is still germane today, as Mr. Leland will address in his presentation in psychic and spiritual development.

Kurt Leland, is an award-winning poet and composer and author of five nonfiction books, and maintains an intuitive counseling practice called "Spiritual Orienteering" in the Boston area.
