Optional Winter Park Tours for Sunday afternoon:

1) Morse Museum of American Art (1 hour) The world’s most comprehensive collection of works by Louis Comfort Tiffany stained glass art is housed in this museum, which includes jewelry, pottery, and paintings.
Cost: \$5

2) Winter Park’s Scenic Boat Tour (1 hour) Adventuresome for those seeking to be among the flora and fauna of the area. This narrated cruise on an 18 passenger pontoon boat goes through 12 miles of beautiful southern lakes and canals. **Cost: \$12**

3) Hannibal Square (1 hour) A historic neighborhood which features nine sites on the National Register of Historic Places. A stroll through Olde Winter Park features small, winding brick streets, with lovely southern flora and unique shopping. **Cost: Free** (Unless you decide to shop on your own, of course!)

Optional tours for Sunday afternoon will follow lunch at San Pedro. Please **do not** include payment for the tours in your payment to the Federation treasurer.
