THEOSOPHY IN THE 21ST CENTURY Keynote Speakers

Tim Boyd has been serving as international President of the Theosophical Society Adyar since April of 2014. He is a founding member of a spiritual community which was active in Chicago for more than 25 years. The group worked with troubled youth, taught meditation and healing methods, established organic food gardens on vacant lots, purchased and renovated numerous residential buildings in the area, and placed bee hives on the roofs of buildings. His involvement with the Theosophical Order of Service and the Chushul orphanage in Tibet led to an audience with the Dalai Lama which resulted in the TSA sponsoring his visit to Chicago in July of 2011 for a two day event attended by ten-thousand people. He speaks and conducts workshops around the world.
