For the benefit of those users of the Theosophical Classics CD-ROM who wish to migrate to any Windows 64-bit operating system, *i.e.*, XP, Vista or Windows 7, we have updated and repackaged the original version of the program as it uses the 16-bit version of MediaViewer and will not work with 64-bit data types and addresses.

The new version, Theosophical Classics.msi, keeps all the original files in a single package but adds the files needed by the 32-bit version of MediaViewer. It will work in any modern Windows operating environment, whether 32- or 64-bit. The upgrade is expressly limited to system compatibility and ease of installation. There are no other modifications to the original program.

To install, just double-click Theosophical Classics.msi. It is a single file that self-extracts and installs the necessary files and creates a desktop icon.

Known issues:

1. The original program uses a set of seven fonts that are necessary to display foreign words and symbols, Sanskrit Times and six WordPerfect fonts: Greek (Century, Courier, Helvetica) Hebrew David, MathA, and MultinationalA Roman. These are provided in a separate folder and will have to be installed manually.
2. On the opening screen, the links to the entire text of *Isis Unveiled* and *Key to Theosophy* are not working. Access to these titles under "Search" is unaffected.
